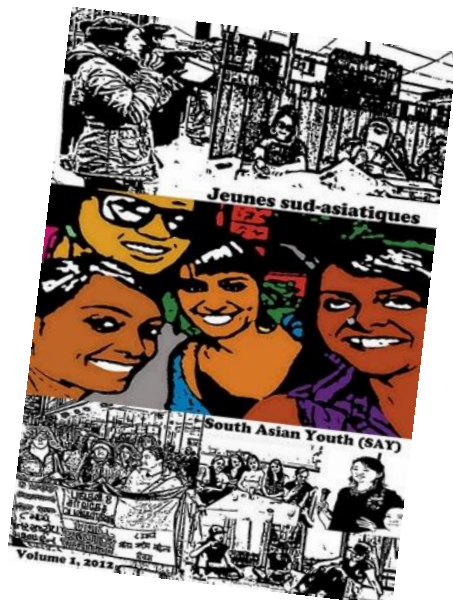


Anti-racist feminism:
